

Why?

- Many students and adult learners belong to the "Netflix generation". Regardless of whether young or old, people enjoy watching and discussing their favorite series.
- Teachers and trainers are increasingly relying on stories to foster learning as our memory stores a story faster and more efficiently than facts.

Developing a course / training as series

for the audience in our teaching events, workshops and trainings

- gives orientation about the planned activities for learners and trainers / teachers
- increases the excitement motivation for everybody
- promotes continuity



What defines a series?

- Teaser: A brief foretaste that arouses curiosity
- Recap: Short recap (what happened recently)
- Cliffhanger: Sudden termination of an episode with an open ending
- A mystery that runs through an episode or through the entire season that needs to be solved.

Elements of series in the master's programme

In the master's programme "Media Competence and Digital Literacy", video interviews were incorporated as a mini-series. 4 video interviews were created on the topic of "Social Media in the Cultural Sector". To illustrate the series character, the video interviews were provided with a specific graphic line. The videos were made available to the master's students on an online platform to be used in the asynchronous part of the course.



New Seminar: Reflecting the science fiction series 'Black Mirror' from a legal perspective

In the seminar 'The Black Mirror of Law (Thinking about Law and Technology through Science Fiction)' we analyze the dystopian / utopian scenarios portrayed in the science fiction series 'Black Mirror' from a legal perspective.

Some of the questions we focus on are:

- Would the enacted utopias or dystopias be possible within our current human rights framework?
- How are questions of law and legality addressed in the episodes and how are they negotiated between different actors?
